- **I.** Call to Order: The Board meeting was called to order at 7:16 p.m.
- II. <u>Establish Quorum</u>: A quorum was established.
- III. <u>Approval or Amendment of the Agenda</u>: Two amendments to the agenda. Under New Business #a Resolution regarding use of HOA clubhouse. IX Executive session cancelled.
- **IV. Board Member Updates:** There were no updates
- **V.** <u>Board Minutes:</u> Approval of March 26, 2025 Board Minutes. Ms. Ray-Keeney moved and Ms. Holt seconded to accept these minutes. Passed without objection.
- VI. <u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Treasurer Stanley was absent. Report will be given at May 28, 2025 Board meeting.
- VII. Unfinished Business: There was no unfinished business.

## VIII. New Business:

a. This Resolution was mis-numbered in the Agenda. The correct number is 2013-4. Discussion ensued regarding the use of the clubhouse by outside organizations. At the present time two public organizations have requested use of building; King City Police Department and Clean Water Services. The resolution was originally written because the clubhouse is not a public building. Washington County Community Participation Organization (CPO) wanted to conduct their monthly meetings at the clubhouse. They did so, but have since moved to a public building. No formal action was taken at this time, but the Board will decide at the May 28, 2025 Board meeting whether to call for a formal rescission of 2013-4, or continue to allow presentations from government and community organizations.

- **b.** Joe Mulder, ALC Chairman presented the following proposals.
  - 1. <u>Bricci Construction</u> presented a proposal for \$7,300.00 for replacement of 7 sidewalk panels at the corner of SW 129<sup>th</sup> Terr./Peachvale St. To be paid from GL #20-6390. Ms. Ray-Keeney moved and Ms. Holt seconded to accept this proposal. Passed without objection.
  - 2. <u>Teufel Landscape</u> Presented a proposal for \$2,025.00 to flush out the French drain located on the south side of central greenway. To be paid from GL #20-6435. Ms. Baese moved and Ms. Holt seconded to accept this proposal. Passed without objection.
  - 3. Halstead's Arboriculture Consultants, Inc. Presented a proposal for \$800.00 for pruning and treatment for turpentine beetle damage on a Black Pine tree located between the Wimbledon pathway and 16016 SW Wimbledon Ct. To be paid from GL #20-7780. Ms. Ray-Keeney moved and Mr. Mustard seconded to accept this proposal. Passed without objection.
  - 4. <u>Halstead's Arboriculture Consultants, Inc.</u> presented a proposal for \$1,095.00 for removal of Sugar Maple tree located at 12845 SW Overgaard. Stump will also be ground down to ground level. To be paid from GL #20-7705. Ms. Baese moved and Ms. Holt seconded to accept this proposal. Passed without objection.
  - 5. <u>Teufel Landscape</u> presented a bid for \$675.00 for irrigation component repairs and replacement. Go be paid from GL #20-7780. Ms. Ray-Keeney moved and Mr. Mustard seconded to accept this proposal. Passed without objection.
